

OFF-LICENCE**Sections 17 to 20, and 64 Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012**

Section 40 applies to this licence

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **THE KOHA COLLECTIVE LIMITED** is authorised to sell alcohol on but not from the premises situated at 69 Grand Vue Road, Rotorua, and known as "**THE KOHA COLLECTIVE**", to any person for consumption off the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) No alcohol is to be delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday or Christmas Day or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day.
- (b) Alcohol may be sold at any time on any day by remote sale but may only be delivered to the buyer (or a person on the buyer's behalf) during the hours of.

Monday to Sunday - 6.00 am to 11.00 pm

- (c) The whole office is undesignated
- (d) This licence has been applied for under section 35 (complimentary sales) alcohol must be complimenting gift basket purchases and not sold as an individual item.
- (e) The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force –

- (a) either
 - (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either –
 - (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.
